

TIM MUNSON FELLOWSHIP AWARD

The Tim Munson Fellowship Award is an annual \$5,000 award for a graduate student studying Geosciences at the University of Oklahoma, Oklahoma State University or the University of Tulsa.

The Tim Munson Fellowship Award is named for a past OERB Board Chairman. Munson has been a leader in the OERB Student Education Programs since 2001 and continues to go above and beyond in his service to the OERB and oil and natural gas industry.

Munson is originally from the small Texas Panhandle town of Canadian. He was inspired to pursue a career in the Oil & Gas industry by his father who is a petroleum geologist. Munson started his career in 1986 working as a geologist at Mesa Petroleum in Amarillo, TX. He later relocated to Oklahoma City where he went to work for Cabot Oil and Gas Corporation. In November 1997, he joined Spartan Resources, LLC. Munson where he serves as the Exploration Manager.

Munson first became involved with the OERB 18 years ago when he began volunteering as a Petro Pro. He has served on the Scholastic Outreach Committee since 2001, and was chairman of the committee for two years. Munson has worked on the OERB's curriculum development teams for Core Energy and Fossils to Fuel 2. He has been instrumental in the development of the OERB's PetroTech program. Since that program began in 2007, he has been the liaison between the industry and the students. Munson has been an instructor for the program for 11 years and continues to instruct and mentor students. The OERB has recognized Munson for his education efforts by awarding him with our Randy Foutch award in 2003 and 2007. And in addition to all of the new responsibilities he has taken on as an OERB Board Member, he is still managing to go back to his roots and volunteer for Petro Pro presentations. Since 2001, Munson has made over 165 presentations reaching close to 5,500 students.
