LAND RESTORATION



2021 HIGHLIGHTS

Capitol Project

For 79 years, a historic oil and natural gas artifact has been located near the south steps of the Oklahoma State Capitol. It has been an illustration of the heritage of oil and natural gas industry in Oklahoma, which has driven our economy for more than 100 years. The artifact includes equipment associated with a well from 1942 that produced more than 1.5 million barrels of oil and 1.6 billion cubic feet of natural gas. In 1986, the well was plugged and donated as a historical artifact to the Oklahoma Historical Society.

This year, the OERB partnered with Phillips 66 to remove the artifact so the space can be repurposed by the state. The work was completed at no cost to taxpayers and through voluntary funding from the people of Oklahoma Oil & Natural Gas and Phillips 66.







STUDENT (PRIMARY) EDUCATION

Since 1996, education has been a core mission of the people of Oklahoma Oil & Natural Gas. We are committed to investing in the next generation of innovators and gamechangers. Through teacher resources, grants, field trips and STEM Camps, the OERB continued to make an impact in 2021.

2021 HIGHLIGHTS

STEM Maker Camps

The people of Oklahoma Oil & Natural Gas sponsored science, technology, engineering and math (STEM) camps for more than 300 students in 2021. Led by Engage Learning, a student-driven STEM program, sponsored by the OERB, 26 Oklahoma classes were provided access to immersive engineering and design camps.

The STEM Maker Camps are led by an experienced team of Engage Learning coaches and include activities like electrical circuits, coding, digital design, and 3D-printing. The lessons are designed to develop the critical skills of creative problem-solving, critical thinking, collaboration and communication.

These fourteen school districts hosted camps in 2021: Anadarko, Norman, Lawton, Yale, Ketchum, Blue Jacket, Newcastle, Deer Creek-Lamont, Clinton, Cleveland, Maysville, Sayre, Bethel and Central Intermediate.





Petroleum Scholarships

Through funding from the people of Oklahoma Oil and Natural Gas, students majoring in petroleum-related fields at the University of Oklahoma, the University of Tulsa, and Oklahoma State University have an opportunity to get scholarships each year.


