

- GPT IS JUST ONE SOURCE OF TAX REVENUE CONTRIBUTED BY THE OIL AND NATURAL GAS INDUSTRY. INCOME AND AD VALOREM TAXES ACCOUNT FOR OTHER MAJOR SOURCES.
- OIL AND NATURAL GAS IS THE ONLY INDUSTRY THAT HAS A TAX THAT PROVIDES SIGNIFICANT FUNDING FOR DEDICATED USES LIKE EDUCATION, LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICTS, AND COUNTY ROADS.
- ACCOUNTING FOR EXPENDITURES IN THE GENERAL REVENUE FUND, OIL AND NATURAL GAS CONTRIBUTIONS WILL FUND PUBLIC EDUCATION BY AN ESTIMATED \$800 MILLION IN FY22.
